- 8. Nancy Birkus, NCTM Affiliate Central Region and consultant for Learning Point Associates sent greetings from Cathy Seely, NCTM President. There are 238 affiliates in US and Canada and 12 student affiliates. There is a new membership that costs \$46 and entitles you to everything but the print journals. You may download 10 articles per year. It is seen as a way to increase membership. All affiliates are struggling with membership. The National convention used to have attendance greater that 100,000 and it is now down to 90,000. Because of cost, the Regional conventions must draw 3000 attendees.
