Old Business

- 1. Treasurer's report from Diana McCann

Bill will try to recruit a few others to serve on the committee.
- 5. By-laws Bill will appoint a committee to look at the SDCTM constitution and bylaws and report back to the general membership concerning possible revisions. (Gomer, Van Eye)
- 6. Other Mike Catalano talked about the American Regional Mathematics League (ARML) contest held each year at the University of Iowa. In the past he has taken a high school team from South Dakota to the contest. If anyone is interested in taking over the team for South Dakota, contact Mike. There are some funds available for fees, travel, etc.
